- 2. In the ICT SHSM program, students are required to complete 4 major credits, a grade 11 Math, a grade 12 English, 1 additional credit and 2 co-op credits. In addition, students will complete 6 general and sector-related certifications, reach-ahead activities (visits to colleges and universities), and other field trips.
- 3. Completion of all SHSM requirements requires a high degree of commitment on the part of the student. ICT SHSM students are responsible for monitoring their own progress in the program. Teachers and guidance counselors will be happy to assist.
- 4. The early-bird application is due at the end of February. Hand in applications to Ms. Gorski in room 129 or to the tech office. Applications **can** be submitted after this deadline. See any SHSM teacher to apply after the deadline.
